Abstract

This article reviews the main theoretical models that explain the electoral behavior — sociological model of voting behavior, psychosocial model of voting behavior and rational choice theory —, stressing the continuity and theoretical complementarity between them. It also proposes a reconceptualization of the concept of partisanship in order to integrate all relevant contributions of the three main models of voting behavior in a holistic approach to electoral behavior.

Resumo

Neste artigo analisam-se os principais modelos teóricos utilizados para explicar o comportamento eleitoral — modelo sociológico do comportamento eleitoral, modelo psicossocial do comportamento eleitoral e a teoria da escolha racional —, acentuando a continuidade e a complementaridade teórica que os une. Propõe-se também uma reconceptualização do conceito de partidário, a fim de integrar, em uma abordagem holística para o comportamento eleitoral, todas as contribuições relevantes dos três principais modelos de comportamento eleitoral.
